Subject: South Korean passport holders may entry to Russia without visas/voucher for 60 days

Tourists of South Korea no more require a visa for a short-term visit of Russia, as an agreement to this effect will come into force on 01.01.2014 (Official press-relise of Korean MFA).

Under the visa-free short-term tourist travel agreement signed between the two countries in this year, their citizens are eligible for entry, exit, transit or stay on the territory of the other country for up to 60 days from each period of 180 days.

Citizens of many countries can entry to Russia without visas: almost all CIS contries, Thailand, Serbia, Montenegro, Turkey, Israel, SAR Hong Kong, SAR Macau, Brazil, Chile, Argentina, Cuba, Peru, Venezuela, Fiji and etc.

Since autumn of 2002 Russian Government has been making attempts to build visa free zone between Russia and Schengen Contries, but European officials have always denied.
